Associated Builders and Contractors of California (ABC CA) is a statewide organization representing working Californians in carpentry, construction, construction craft laborer, electrical, low voltage, painting, plumbing, pipefitting, and sheet metal who are building commercial, industrial and affordable housing projects, and we write to express our support position on AB 736 (Wicks), a bill that authorizes the Affordable Housing Bond Act of 2026 to place a \$10 billion housing bond on the March 2, 2026 primary ballot to fund production of affordable housing and supportive housing.
